A combined meeting of anti ragging committee and anti ragging squad was held on 8th Aug'17 at office chamber of the Superintendent, Cancer Hospital, GMC. The members present in the meeting discussed about the menace of ragging that may happen in educational institution after admission of a new batch. To prevent such incidents inside the campus of GMC, the committee members suggested various measures and accordingly the following decisions were taken by the Committee:

- 1. There will be zero tolerance for the ragging in this College, Hostel, and Hospital premises or in any other places outside.
- 2. All Monitors/Wardens/Superintendent of hostels are to report to the Committee whenever any incident of ragging takes place inside or outside the college campus.
- 3. Intimidation in the form of mental/physical/sexual abuse, verbal abuse, indecent behavior, criminal intimidation/wrongful restraint, undermining human dignity, financial exploitation /extortion, use of force to the freshers will be seriously dealt with as per the law.
- 4. All Superintendents of hostels are to be requested to hold freshers' social before 31st of August'2017.
- 5. A new comer should not be directed /compelled to attend to any personal work of seniors in the hostel, hospital or outside. No senior can borrow money from the new comers and cannot force to purchase their belongings (bone sets, books etc).
- 6. Surprise visit of the hostel/college will be conducted by the Anti Ragging Squad of Gauhati Medical College & Hospital at any time.
- 7. Verbal/SMS/Whatsapp/E-Mail/Written Complaints by the freshers or their guardians will be taken seriously and action will be recommended on the offender as per the law.
